

TRADE FACT SHEET : ULURU & SURROUNDS



Located 462 kilometres south-west of Alice Springs, Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park is home to the world-famous Uluru/Ayers Rock and the 32 weathered rock domes known as Kata Tjuta/The Olgas. The sight of these extraordinary ancient natural wonders glowing and appearing to change colour at sunrise or sunset is an unforgettable natural show.



Getting There

Direct flights to Uluru are available from Sydney and Melbourne and Qantas link also operate a daily service between Alice Springs and the Rock.

Complimentary return coach transfers from Ayers Rock Airport to Yulara (Ayers Rock Resort) meet every scheduled flight.



Getting Around

With over 65 tours, local activities and attractions within the Resort and the Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, days will be action-packed.

Another option is to hire a car from Ayers Rock Airport or Alice Springs and create your own itinerary.

FAQs

Q: I should I suggest clients take a day trip from Uluru to Alice Springs?

A: No, it is a five-hour drive and there won't be enough time to do everything.

Q: How many nights should I recommend for a stay at Uluru?

A: 2 nights are ok for a weekend, but with big distances and sunrise/sunset touring, 4 nights is more comfortable. You can then fit in an overnight at the spectacular Kings Canyon



Travel Tips for Clients

- For clients who self-drive, the park entry fee can be bought at the gates and is \$25 for three days
- If traveling on the Ghan it is possible to arrange a break at Alice Springs, allowing your clients to stay a bit longer to explore Uluru, Kata Tjuta and Kings Canyon.



Weather

May to September is a popular time of the year for visitors with clear skies and minimal rainfall.

Rain is hard to predict but more likely to fall from October to March.

During the summer months from December to March there are fewer crowds.
